



## Cat Grass

Buzzy® grow kits are designed so you can easily grow tasty grass for your cat.

It is important to know what to expect from the seeds you are growing. For best results, please follow these instructions. Plants can be started indoors and moved outdoors after danger of last frost.

### Directions:

- Place the soil pellet in a cup and fill with lukewarm water.
- Wait 5 minutes while the soil absorbs the water.
- Fluff the soil with a fork.
- Add ¾ of the soil to the plastic container.
- Open the seed packet and sprinkle the seeds evenly on the soil.
- Cover with the remainder of soil.
- Water the soil.
- Place in a sunny location.

### Tips:

- Germination requires constant moisture.
- Do not allow the soil to become soggy or the seeds will rot.
- Use a fine mist or watering can to keep the area moist.
- Take notice of light requirements.
- The optimum height for your grass is 3" – 4". Keep your grass looking neat by cutting with scissors or garden shears.

Annual – A flowering plant that will grow, flower and die all within the same year

Perennial - A plant that has roots that survive from year to year

Full Sun – 6 or more hours of direct sunlight daily

Partial Sun – 4 – 6 hours of direct sun daily
