



Garden Grow Pots

A garden is fun and easy and can be beautiful and productive no matter how big or small. Buzzy® grow kits are designed so you can easily grow flowers for your home and garden.

It is important to know what to expect from the seeds you are growing. For best results, please follow these instructions. Plants can be started indoors and moved outdoors after danger of last frost.

Directions:

- Place the soil pellets in a separate bowl and add 1 cup lukewarm water.
- Wait 5 minutes while the soil absorbs the water.
- Fluff the soil with a fork.
- Add $\frac{3}{4}$ of the soil to the container.
- Open the seed container very carefully and add one seed on the soil.
- Cover with the remainder of soil.
- Water the soil.
- Place in a sunny location.

Tips:

- Germination requires constant moisture.
- Do not allow the soil to become soggy or the seeds will rot.
- Use a fine mist or watering can to keep the area moist.
- If you have extra seeds, you can use the remainder to plant outside or replant them later in the container.
- Take notice of light requirements.
- Transplant your plants when they reach 2 – 4 inches. To transplant, moisten the seedbed and carefully separate the delicate plants taking special care not to damage the stems or roots while moving. Transplant 8 – 10 inches apart to larger containers or in your garden.
- Staking helps new seedlings grow strong and straight and ensures that all growing flowers receive enough sunlight. find a few straight twigs or sticks and gently push them into the soil behind each seedling. Loosely tie the seedling to the stick with string.

Annual – A flowering plant that will grow, flower and die all within the same year

Perennial - A plant that has roots that survive from year to year

Full Sun – 6 or more hours of direct sunlight daily

Partial Sun – 4 – 6 hours of direct sun daily
