



## Mini Greenhouses

A garden is fun and easy and can be beautiful and productive no matter how big or small. Buzzy® grow kits are designed so you can easily grow flowers or herbs for your home and garden.

It is important to know what to expect from the seeds you are growing. For best results, please follow these instructions. Plants can be started indoors and moved outdoors after danger of last frost.

### Directions:

- Place the soil pellets in a separate bowl and add 1 cup of lukewarm water.
- Wait 5 minutes while the soil absorbs the water.
- Fluff the soil with a fork.
- Add ¾ of the soil evenly into the 6 terra cotta pots.
- open the seed packets and sprinkle 5 seeds evenly on the soil. Use only 1 seed variety per pot.
- Cover with the remainder of soil.
- Water the soil.
- Place the terra cotta pots back into the plastic greenhouse and carefully close.
- Place in a sunny location.

### Tips:

- Germination requires constant moisture.
- Do not allow the soil to become soggy or the seeds will rot.
- Use a fine mist or watering can to keep the area moist.
- Turn the greenhouse every few days so all sides receive ample sunlight.
- If you have extra seeds, you can use the remainder to plant outside or replant them later in the containers.
- Take notice of light requirements.
- Reuse the plastic greenhouse for future plantings.
- Transplant your plants when they reach 2 – 4 inches. To transplant, moisten the seedbed and carefully separate the delicate plants taking special care not to damage the stems or roots while moving. Transplant 8 – 10 inches apart to larger containers or in your garden.
- Staking helps new seedlings grow strong and straight and ensures that all growing flowers or fruits receive enough sunlight. Find a few straight twigs or sticks and gently push them into the soil behind each seedling. Loosely tie the seedling to the stick with string.

Annual – A flowering plant that will grow, flower and die all within the same year

Perennial - A plant that has roots that survive from year to year

Full Sun – 6 or more hours of direct sunlight daily

Partial Sun – 4 – 6 hours of direct sun daily
