



Porcelain Grow Pots

A garden is fun and easy and can be beautiful and productive no matter how big or small. Buzzy® grow kits are designed so you can easily grow herbs or strawberries for your home and garden.

It is important to know what to expect from the seeds you are growing. For best results, please follow these instructions. Plants can be started indoors and moved outdoors after danger of last frost.

Directions:

Remove the seeds and soil from the container.

Open the soil bag and empty into a bowl.

Pour 2 cups of water into your soil and mix.

- Add the soil to your container.
- For Herbs: Open each seed packet and sprinkle 5 seeds evenly on the soil in separate areas of the container. You can also place seeds in the side pockets. Seeds need to be approx 1/2" below the soil line.
- For Strawberries: Strawberry seeds are very tiny so carefully open the seed packet and sprinkle the seeds into your hand and place evenly on the soil in separate areas of the container. Gently press into the soil.
- Place in a sunny location and water whenever the soil feels dry to the touch.

Tips:

- Germination requires constant moisture.
- Do not allow the soil to become soggy or the seeds will rot.
- Use a fine mist or watering can to keep the area moist.
- If you have extra seeds, you can use the remainder to plant outside or replant them later in the containers.
- Rotate the container regularly so that all sides receive ample sunlight.
- Take notice of light requirements.
- For Herbs: These herbs can be grown indoors year round. Cut the leaves from your herbs and use when cooking.
- For Strawberries: Keep the strawberries in as much sun as they will tolerate without drying too rapidly, especially when the berries are ripening. Be patient – strawberry seeds are slow to emerge but well worth the wait.

Annual – A flowering plant that will grow, flower and die all within the same year

Perennial - A plant that has roots that survive from year to year

Full Sun – 6 or more hours of direct sunlight daily

Partial Sun – 4 – 6 hours of direct sun daily
