



Watering Can

A garden is fun and easy and can be beautiful and productive no matter how big or small. Buzzy® grow kits are designed so you can easily grow decorative grass for your home and garden.

It is important to know what to expect from the seeds you are growing. For best results, please follow these instructions. Plants can be started indoors and moved outdoors after danger of last frost.

Directions:

- Place the soil pellets in a bowl and add 2 cups of lukewarm water.
- Wait 5 minutes while the water is absorbed and then fluff the soil with a fork. Make sure the soil is moist.
- Add the soil to your watering can.
- Open the seed packet and sprinkle the seeds into your hand.
- Select 10 seeds and one by one gently push them ¼" into the soil. Cover with surrounding soil.
- Place in a sunny location and water regularly.
- Keep the soil moist but do not over water.
- Transplant seedlings when 6" tall.

Tips:

- Plants can be started indoors and moved outdoors after danger of last frost.
- To transplant seedlings, moisten the seedbed and carefully separate the plants taking care not to damage the roots or stems. Transplant 8" – 10" apart to larger containers or in your garden.
- Extra seeds can be planted in other containers or outside. If you choose to save the seeds, put them back into the seed packet and close tightly. Keep in a cool dark location for future use.
- Daisies can take up to 20-30 days to germinate. Please be patient.



Daisy

Type: Perennial

Light: full sun

Height (inches): 12

Germination (days): 14 - 21

WARNING:

Do not eat seeds

Annual – A flowering plant that will grow, flower and die all within the same year

Perennial - A plant that has roots that survive from year to year

Full Sun – 6 or more of direct sunlight daily

Partial Sun – 4 – 6 hours of direct sun daily
